Rule 9

Proposer – BBC & Old Coventrians

- · Bedworth bowling Club & Old Coventrians wish to propose a change of rule.
- Rule 9 where it says a team shall consist of 12 players, Delete 12 insert 10.

Proposal Defeated 12 in favour & 25 against

Rule 9

Proposer - Walsgrave

 Delete - "In Saturday League matches a team shall consist of 12 players" and replace with "In Saturday League Matches teams will play 8 single games and 4 double games"......(if carried rule 9 will require amending)

Background

Teams have regularly struggled to consistently get 12 players out on a Saturday, this proposal of playing 8 singles and 4 doubles still results in 12 matches, however Clubs have the option to play with either 8 or 16 players within their Saturday team. It may also give Clubs the option to submit more teams.

Proposal defeated unanimously - only 5 in favour

Rule 10

1. Proposer - Walsgrave

A re-occurrence in the same season may result in a team being expelled from the League. Coventry & District League matches shall take precedence over all Cup competitions and any outside League matches. Clubs with more than one green must inform the League by the formation meeting which green is being used throughout the season by each of their teams."

Rule 11

1. Proposer - Albany

Proposal

Change rule 11 to change the words "MALE only for the Mid-Week leagues" to "male only for the Premier/Mid-Week league".

New rule to read "All players must be separately registered by name and BCGBA number for each league (male only for Premier/Mid-week league), and may not be registered by more than one club for the same league. [Continues unchanged]"

Background:

The Thursday league has shrunk dramatically over the last decade (by a third; only Sunday fairs worse). Without protecting existing teams and encouraging new teams the Thursday League is likely to shrink to three divisions within five years. We enjoy playing in this league and we want it to be strong and vibrant.

Warwick & Worcester, operate only mixed gender leagues and this has had no detrimental effect on the standard of bowling. The change has increased membership, revenue, protected existing 'B' sides and also increased the number of teams.

Albany believe we should not divide players based on gender, but allow them to compete based on ability. However we recognise that there is a strong feeling that at least one league should be gender restricted. Therefore our proposal is that only the Thursday league is changed.

Rule 11

2. Rule Revision Motion: Sunday league

Proposer: Albany

Proposal

Change rule 2 to delete the words "(male only)". New rule to read.

All players must be separately registered by name and B.C.G.B.A. number to the League and may not be registered by more than one club. All registrations must be in the hands of the match secretary 7 days before playing a match. Players may only play for one club and no player may play for more than one team on the same fixture date."

Background

Since 2000, across all the North Midlands league, the Sunday League has struggled to maintain team numbers and has seen by far the largest decline (nearly 50%). We must protect existing teams and encourage new teams or else the Sunday League could become unviable in the next few years. We enjoy playing in this league and we want the Sunday League to be successful.

- By allowing all to play equally in the league, the following benefits will be brought to all our clubs:
- It will improve our chances to be able to maintain existing teams and field additional teams
- Our women bowlers would be able to play more often
- Allow couples and families to compete in Sunday matches and boost junior membership
- The inclusive nature will have a positive benefit

3. Proposer: Management Committee

For clarification purposes add in "Thursdays" into the paragraph.......... All players must be separately registered by name and B.C.G.B.A number for both Saturday, Mid-Week, Thursday and Sunday Leagues – same applies to Rule 14

Rule 12

1. Proposer - Walsgrave

Delete "No transfers in the last 4 weeks of the season", replace with. "No player transfers or players not North Midland affiliated shall be signed within the last 4 weeks of the season, however players that are newly BCGBA affiliated can sign during this period.
